

Over the coming weeks and months we, as a school, will of course be addressing issues raised by the parental community in the recent parents questionnaire. The results of the questionnaire have been shared with governors as well and you'll hear from them, through their newsletters, what they will be doing to address specific issues.

This week we wanted to let you know what we are doing to work on improving behaviour across the school. A new policy has recently been implemented - staff who had worked with the previous policy for some time felt it was ineffective and outdated. All staff are working hard to ensure the new agreed policy is consistently implemented by all adults. Attached to this ParentMail is a simple flowchart (which the children should also be familiar with as it is on display in all classrooms) which outlines the basic components of the policy. Of course for some children additional and alternative measures are in place which we discuss with those individual families as and when the need arises. A copy of the full policy is on the school website.

Kingfisher Class have just started learning about plants in Science. As part of this learning, they have been sketching different plants in art with Mrs. Yeates, including these beautiful daffodils. We are also going to be growing potatoes throughout the term. We have 2 different varieties to grow – rocket and jester potatoes. They are currently chitting so that the shoots grow.
