



ART

In art this half term the children will be sketching plants and insects as well as doing other observational drawings. They will also be investigating the famous artist Henri Matisse and attempting some work using his unique style.

COMPUTING

In computing this half term the children will work on a short sports video all about athletics. They will have time to edit and improve their video and finally add commentary. They will then assess and present their footage to the class.

In PSHE this term, our theme will be relationships. The children will focus on:

- Knowing how to make friends
- Solving friendship problems when they occur
- Showing respect towards others
- Knowing and show what makes a good relationship

PSHE



In Science this half term the children will be learning about light. They will learn about the following:

- They need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light.
- Light is reflected from surfaces, that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes.
- Shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by a solid object.
- They will find patterns in the way that the size of shadows changes throughout the day.

SCIENCE



ENGLISH

In English this half term the children will be focusing on the following genres:

- * Non-fiction: Creating tourist attraction guides for Stonehenge.
- * Adventure and Mystery: The Green Ship by Quentin Blake.
- * Play scripts: Children will have the chance to learn a short play in groups, to perform to the rest of the class.

The children will also continue their handwriting, grammar, spelling and punctuation lessons.

In Design technology this half term, the children will be designing and making their own across the body bag out of felt. They will look at a range of existing products before designing their own.

HISTORY

The children will continue the topic of Stone Age to Iron Age. They will now move on to learning about the changes the Bronze Age brought before finally exploring the more recent Iron Age.

MATHS



In maths this half term the children will be focusing on the following:

Measurement:

- Adding and subtracting length
- Calculating perimeter of 2-D shapes

Fractions:

- Finding a fraction of a number
- Adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator
- Recognising equivalent fractions
- Solving problems with fractions

Time:

- Reading the time on an analogue clock to the nearest minute.
- Telling the time on a 24 hour clock
- Calculating time durations of events

P.E.



In PE this half term the children will continue to have 1 indoor and 1 outdoor session per week. Their indoor PE will be swimming at Rivers Meet Leisure Centre on a Wednesday morning. In outdoor PE we will be doing athletics. This will include elements of running, jumping and throwing. Please ensure your child has a pair of trainers for outdoor PE as well as a hat for warm weather.

MUSIC



In music this half term the children will focus on "painting with sound". They will think about the effect music has on us and how music is composed to suit different occasions. They will experiment layering sounds from different instruments in small groups and performing this to a class audience.

FRENCH



In French this half term, the children will continue to learn basic conversational skills as well as being able to talk about their families and order food in a French restaurant. They will also focus on other basic classrooms commands as well as learning songs and rhymes.
