

This half term, the children will be focusing on art in the environment. They will explore art in the nature garden and on the school field. They will also be looking at pattern and colour and learning about the artist Henri Matisse.

This half term, the children will be focusing on communicating effectively and safely using the internet. Our main focus will be composing, editing, sending and receiving e-mails. The children will also use their ICT skills during other subjects throughout this half term.

In PSHCE this half term the children will explore the theme 'Changes'. They will reflect on emotional changes that have happened in their lives so far and how that made them feel. They will also learn about physical changes to their bodies. They will also learn about the life cycle of humans, including how babies grow and develop. Towards the end of term they will discuss the change and transition to year four and any queries or questions they have.

In Science this half term the children will be learning about a healthy and balanced diet. This will form part of our living and growing themed topic. We will be hatching ducklings in Kingfisher class! We will focus on the life cycle of a duckling and the hatching process. We will keep you informed about this exciting event.

In music this half term the children will focus on 'singing games.' They will learn many different singing games and also attempt to create their own, adding instruments to accompany their words.



FRENCH

In French this half term, the children will continue to learn basic conversational skills as well as how to ask simple questions in French. They are becoming very confident now on their numbers, colours and basic classroom commands.



ENGLISH

In English this half term the children will be focusing on the following themes:

We will also continue to work on the skills of punctuation, spelling, grammar skills and handwriting formation within lessons.



MATHS

In Maths this term the children will be focusing on the following:

- * Read the time to the nearest minute on an analogue clock
- * Read the time from a 24 hour clock
- * Add money and calculate change
- * Capacity
- * Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator
- * Equivalent fractions
- * Solve 1 and 2 step problems using statistics
- * Written methods for + - x ÷

P.E.



In PE this half term the children will continue to have 1 indoor and 1 outdoor session per week. Their indoor session will be swimming at Rivers Meet Leisure Centre on a Wednesday morning. They have 5 more swimming sessions remaining. In outdoor PE we will be completing the last of our athletics and moving on to the cricket and rounders. Children are welcome to bring in trainers for outdoor PE. Please ensure your child has a hat and extra drinks for warm weather.

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY



In Design Technology the children will be making an across the body bag out of felt. Before half term, they evaluated a number of existing products. Their bag will have a simple motif on the front. They will attach a strap and a press stud to keep the bag securely closed. During this project, the children will learn how to do running stitch as well as a blanket stitch.
